# Conference Registration Information

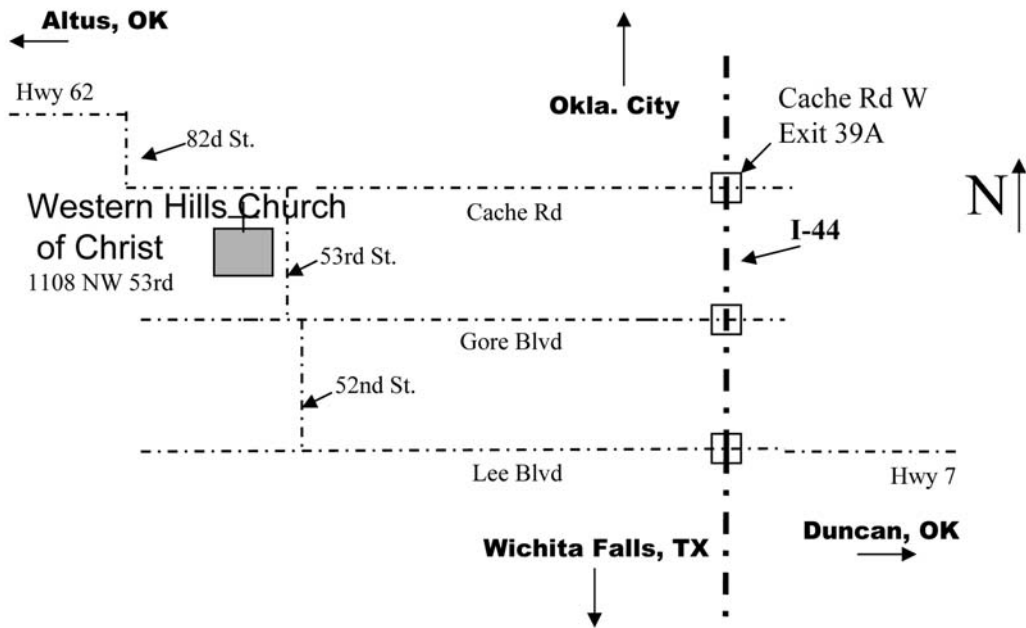
